Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during July, 1954, amounted to 31,955 tons compared with 29,837 tons in the previous month and with 33,968 tons in July, 1953.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 17,917 tons in July, 1954, compared with 21,595 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
