Silver - Output in Canada of primary silver in all forms amounted to 2,357,225 fine ounces in March, 1955, compared with 1,937,960 fine ounces in the previous month and with 2,314,392 fine ounces in March, 1954.

Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during March, 1955, amounted to 36,674 tons compared with 32,068 tons in the previous month and with 28,876 tons in March, 1954.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 22,215 tons in March, 1955, compared with 16,550 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
