Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during June, 1955, amounted to 33,553 tons compared with 37,367 tons in the previous month and with 29,860 tons in June, 1954.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 20,565 tons in June, 1955, compared with 17,007 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
