Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during April, 1956, amounted to 34,790 tons compared with 36,619 tons in the previous month and with 34,719 tons in April, 1955.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 21,339 tons in April, 1956, compared with 21,301 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
