## SILVER, LEAD AND ZINC PRODUCTION

Silver - Output in Canada of primary silver in all forms amounted to 2,080,722 fine ounces in May, 1957, compared with 2,190,294 fine ounces in the previous month and with 2,463,374 fine ounces in May, 1956.

Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during May, 1957, amounted to 34,046 tons compared with 33,306 tons in the previous month and with 35,057 tons in May, 1956.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 20,564 tons in May, 1957, compared with 21,790 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
