Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during January, 1959, amounted to 35,315 tons compared with 34,834 tons in the previous month and with 37,760 tons in January, 1958.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 21,456 tons in January, 1959, compared with 21,801 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
