Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during December, 1959, amounted to 32,867 tons compared with 30,675 tons in the previous month and with 34,795 tons in December, 1958.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 21,963 tons in December, 1959, compared with 21,671 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
