Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during February, 1950, amounted to 32,309 tons compared with 34,980 tons in the previous month and with 29,790 tons in February, 1959.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 21,055 tons in February, 1960, compared with 19,709 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
