Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during July, 1960, amounted to 31,711 tons compared with 33,675 tons in the previous month and with 34,630 tons in July, 1959.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 20,800 tons in July, 1960, compared with 21,055 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
