Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during September, 1960, amounted to 34,997 tons compared with 33,126 tons in the previous month and with 32,090 tons in September, 1959.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totaled 21,633 tons in September, 1960, compared with 20,744 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
