

Silver - Output in Canada of primary silver in all forms amounted to 2,472,876 fine ounces in May, 1961, compared with 2,423,922 fine ounces in the previous month and with 2,354,657 fine ounces in May, 1960.

Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during May, 1%1, amounted to 31,651 tons compared with 28,559 tons in the previous month and with 33,362 tons in May, 1%0.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 22,543 tons in May, 1961, compared with 21,701 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
