Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during June, 1961, amounted to 33,103 tons compared with 31,651 tons in the previous month and with 33,674 tons in June, 1960.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 22,168 tons in June, 1961, compared with 21,294 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
