Silver - Output in Canada of primary silver in all forms amounted to 2,462,870 fine ounces in July, 1961, compared with 2,902,223 fine ounces in the previous month and with 2,919,664 fine ounces in July, 1960.

Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during July, 1%1, amounted to 33,881 tons compared with 33,103 tons in the previous month and with 31,711 tons in July, 1%0.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 22,147 tons in July, 1961, compared with 20,860 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
