Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during August, 1961, amounted to 35,936 tons compared with 33,881 tons in the previous month and with 33,126 tons in August, 1960.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 22,046 tons in August, 1961, compared with 21,203 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
