## SILVER, LEAD AND ZINC PRODUCTION

Silver - Output in Canada of primary silver in all forms amounted to $2,136,891$ fine ounces in May, 1962, compared with $2,269,791$ fine ounces in the previous month and with 2,554,288 fine ounces in May, 1961.
