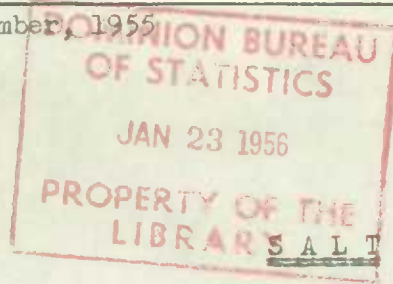

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 92,833 tons in November, 1955, compared with 115,749 tons in the previous month. The November, 1954, shipments totalled 50,470 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 43,748 tons in November, 1955, and 40,796 tons for the month of November, 1954.
