Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 54,494 tons in April, 1956, compared with 61,351 tons in the previous month. The April, 1955, shipments totalled 33,208 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 40,650 tons in April, 1956, and 42,929 tons for the month of April, 1955.
