

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 56,848 tons in May, 1956, compared with 54,494 tons in the previous month. The May, 1955, shipments totalled 43,504 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 40,819 tons in May, 1956, and 49,600 tons for the month of May, 1955.
