SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 101,776 tons in September, 1956, compared with 106,798 tons in the previous month. The September, 1955, shipments totalled 83,905 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 44,480 tons in September, 1956, and 43,761 tons for the month of September, 1955.
