Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 99,442 tons in February, 1957, compared with 121,868 tons in the previous month. The February, 1956, shipments totalled 85,767 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 39,429 tons in February 1957, and 42,550 tons for the month of February, 1956.
