## SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 151,305 tons in October, 1958, compared with 119,147 tons in the previous month. The October, 1957, shipments totalled 128,116 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 55,421 tons in October, 1958, and 46,419 tons for the month of October, 1957.
