Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 128,696 tons in November, 1958, compared with 151,305 tons in the previous month. The November, 1957, shipments totalled 130,965 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 52,891 tons in November, 1958, and 51,282 tons for the month of November, 1957.
