Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 106,706 tons in May, 1958, compared with 61,589 tons in the previous month. The May, 1957 shipments totalled 125,176 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 56,656 tons in May, 1958, and 46,398 tons for the month of May, 1957.
