Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 126,838 tons in June, 1958, compared with 163,362 tons in the previous month. The June, 1957 shipments totalled 131,762 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 51,500 tons in June, 1958, and 44,349 tons for the month of June, 1957.
