## S A L T

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 119,147 tons in September, 1958, compared with 82,978 tons in the previous month. The September 1957, shipments totalled 123,955 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 54,493 tons in September 1958, and 44,308 tons for the month of September, 1957.
