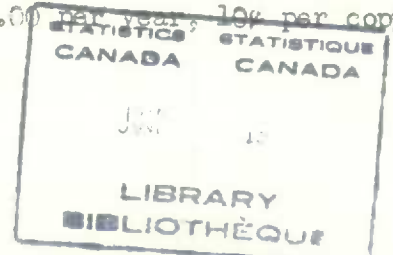

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 170,512 tons in November, 1959, compared with 200,836 tons in the previous month. The November 1958 shipments totalled 128,696 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 137,217 tons in November, 1959, and 52,891 tons for the month of November, 1958.
