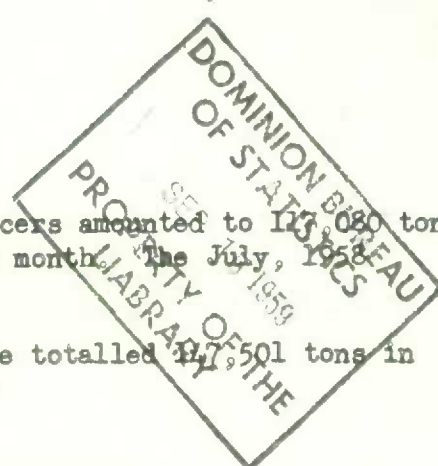

SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 117,080 tons in July, 1959, compared with 85,061 tons in the previous month. The July, 1958 shipments totalled 95,301 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 147,501 tons in July, 1959, and 47,452 tons for the month of July, 1958.
