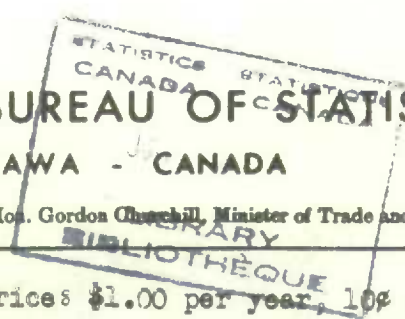

INDUSTRIAL OUTPUT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 146,036 tons in September, 1959, compared with 128,884 tons in the previous month. The September 1958 shipments totalled 119,147 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 130,074 tons in September, 1959, and 54,493 tons for the month of September, 1958.
