

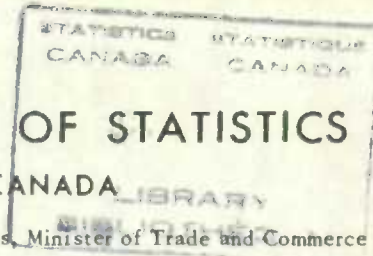

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 23,794 tons in November, 1960, compared with 192,636 tons in the previous month. The November 1959 shipments totalled 200,445 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 119,468 tons in November 1960, and 137,217 tons for the month of November 1959.
