Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 136,338 tons in August 1960, compared with 127,633 tons in the previous month. The August 1959 shipments totalled 128,884 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 127,716 tons in August 1960, and 137,988 tons for the month of August, 1959.
