

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 216,354 tons in October, 1961, compared with 152,637 tons in the previous month. The October, 1960, shipments totalled 192,636 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 134,870 tons in October, 1961, and 129,785 tons for the month of October, 1960.
