

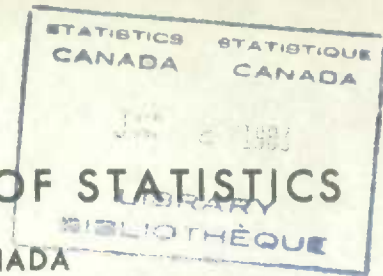

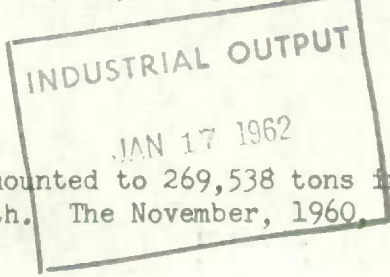

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 269,538 tons in November, 1961, compared with 216,354 tons in the previous month. The November, 1960, shipments totalled 223,794 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 126,519 tons in November, 1961, and 119,468 tons for the month of November, 1960.
