

SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 215,421 tons in December, 1961, compared with 269,538 tons in the previous month. The December, 1960, shipments totalled 170,476 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 112,864 tons in December, 1961, and 119,877 tons for the month of December, 1960.
