

SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 90,440 tons in May, 1961, compared with 75,719 tons in the previous month. The May, 1960 shipments totalled 110,723 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 135,785 tons in May, 1961, and 130,651 tons for the month of May, 1960.
