## SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 84,781 tons in June, 1961, compared with 90,440 tons in the previous month. The June, 1960 shipments totalled 114,160 tons.

Producers usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 129,314 tons in June, 1961, and 128,880 tons for the month of June, 1960.
