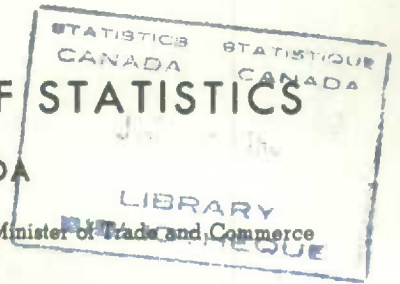

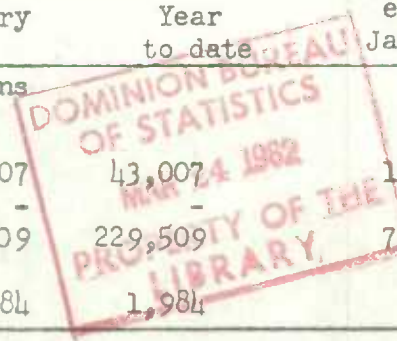

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 274,500 tons in January, 1962, compared with 215,421 tons in the previous month. The January, 1961, shipments totalled 158,762 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 110,176 tons in January, 1962, and 113,809 tons for the month of January, 1961.
