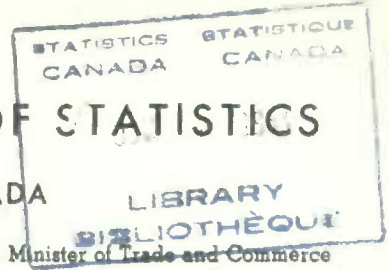

SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 234,664 tons in November 1962, compared with 230,968 tons in the previous month. The November 1961, shipments totalled 269,538 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 109,347 tons in November 1962, and 126,519 tons for the month of November 1961.

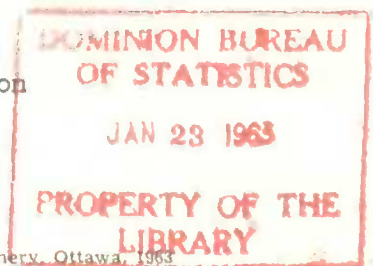
