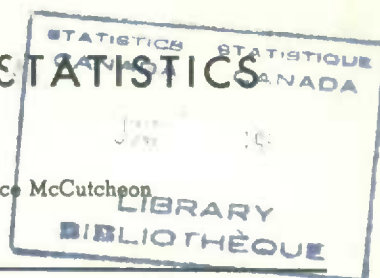

SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 236,004 tons in December 1962, compared with 234,664 tons in the previous month. The December 1961, shipments totalled 215,421 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 112,737 tons in December 1962, and 112,864 tons for the month of December 1961.

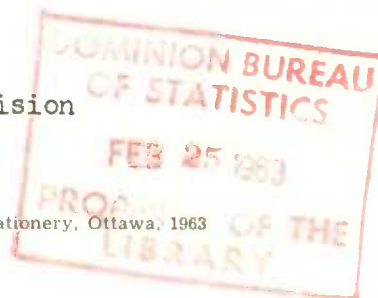
