

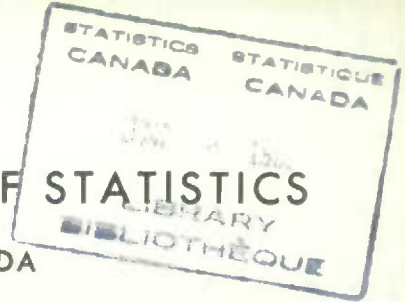

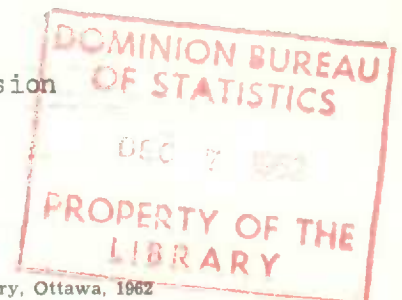
Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 94,132 tons in September 1962, and 115,590 tons for the month of September 1961.
