

SALT


Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 212,694 tons in September 1962, compared with 192,299 tons in the previous month. The September 1961, shipments totalled 152,637 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 94,132 tons in September 1962, and 115,590 tons for the month of September 1961.
