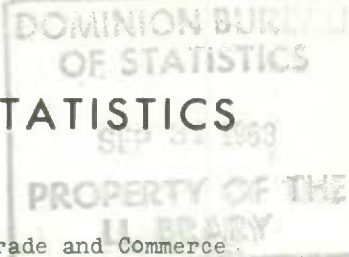

SALT

Shipments of dry common salt by Canadian producers amounted to 168,039 tons in July 1963, compared with 147,213 tons in the previous month. The July 1962 shipments totalled 173,765 tons.

Producers' usage and shipments of salt in brine totalled 119,692 tons in July 1963, and 101,050 tons for the month of July 1962.
