FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1932.

FELDSPAR - The Canadian production of feldspar in November amounted to 433 tons; in the preceding month 482 tons were produced and in November, 1931, the output was 1,294 tons, according to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the eleven months ending November totalled 6,507 tons, a 63.3 per cent decline from the tonnage shipped in the corresponding period of 1931.

There were no imports of crude feldspar into Canada during November; in October 108 tons worth \$1,085 were imported. Importations of ground feldspar in November were negligible; during the preceding month : 2 tons worth \$48 were imported.

SALT - Commercial salt production in Canada increased 11.7 per cent to 18,640 tons in November as compared with the October total of 16,683 tons. Shipments of salt by Canadian producers during the eleven months ending November reached a total of 158,330 tons or 7.4 per cent above the tonnage produced in the corresponding period of last year.

Canada exported 1,288 tons of salt valued at \$4,033 in November as against 616 tons worth \$4,698 exported in October. Importations of salt into Canada advanced 78.9 per cent in November to 16,088 tons appraised at \$100,944; in October 8,994 tons at \$66,234 were imported. The November imports consisted of 5,995 tons from Great Britain, 5,858 tons from the United States, 1,763 tons from Germany, 1,145 tons from the British West Indies, 974 tons from Spain and 353 tons from Newfoundland.
