FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA. NOVEMBER, 1933.

FELDSPAR - The Canadian shipments of feldspar in November amounted to 1,083 tons; in October, 1,233 tons were shipped and in November, 1932, the total was 433 tons, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the eleven months ending November totalled 7,834 tons as compared with 6,507 tons in the corresponding period of 1932.

Ground feldspar imports in November were recorded at 83 tons worth \$1,220; in the preceding month 40 tons at \$478 were imported.

SALT - Shipments of commercial salt by Canadian producers totalled 18,292 tons in November as compared with 14,964 tons in the preceding month and 18,544 tons in November, 1932. An advance of 4.8 per cent was shown in the tonnage shipped during the first eleven months of 1933 over the total for the period January to November, 1932; the quantities were 165,087 tons and 157,518 tons, respectively.

Canada exported 808 tons of salt in November; during the preceding month 540 tons were exported. Imports of salt into Canada in November rose to 20,968 tons worth \$91,551 from the October total of 14,732 tons valued at \$76,935. The United States supplied 40.8 per cent of the November importations; Spain, 30.7 per cent; Great Britain, 16.5 per cent; Germany, 7.0 per cent; British West Indies, 4.0 per cent, and Newfoundland, 1.0 per cent.
