Canada exported 406 tons of salt with a valuation of \$1,635 in March; during the preceding month 262 tons worth \$1,791 were exported. Imports of salt in March totalled 3,516 tons made up of 2,788 tons from the United States, 368 tons from Great Britain, 196 tons from Spain, and 164 tons from the British West Indies. During February the Canadian imports amounted to 3,873 tons.
