FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA, JUNE AND JULY, 1933.

FELDSPAR - Canadian producers shipped 864 tons of feldspar during June and 647 tons in July as compared with 479 tons and 635 tons, respectively, a year ago, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the seven months ending July totalled 3,169 tons; in the corresponding months of 1932 the total was 4,857 tons.

Ground feldspar imports into Canada in June amounted to 33 tons valued at 408 and in July, 41 tons at \$549. These importations were received from the United States.

SALT - The Canadian production of commercial salt amounted to 18,419 tons in June and 16,011 tons in July. During the first seven months of 1933 Canadian producers reported sales totalling 97,203 tons as compared with 92,978 tons in the corresponding period of 1932.

Exports of salt from Canada in June reached a total of 177 tons; in July, 839 tons were exported. Imports of salt into Canada in June advanced to 18,568 tons, made up of 37.4 per cent from Spain, 20.2 per cent from the United States, 19.3 per cent from Great Britain, 17.0 per cent from the British West Indies, 4.4 per cent from Germany, and 1.7 per cent from Newfoundland. In July, salt importations totalled 14,573 tons consisting of 4,273 tons from the United States, 3,536 tons from Great Britain, 3,004 tons from the British West Indies, 2,060 tons from Germany, 1,650 tons from Spain and 50 tons from Newfoundland.
