FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA, OCTOBER, 1934.

FELDSPAR - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the shipments of Canadian feldspar reached a total of 1,910 tons in October; in the preceding month 1,865 tons were shipped and in October, a year ago, 1,484 tons were shipped. Shipments of feldspar during the ten months ending October totalled 12,733 tons or 54.2 per cent above the tonnage shipped in the corresponding period of 1933.

Imports of ground feldspar into Canada during the ten months ending October, 1934, totalled 796 tons appraised at \$\(\pi\)11,870; in the corresponding period of 1933 importations amounted to 353 tons worth \$\(\pi\)5,332.

SALT - Commercial salt production in Canada during October reached a total of 21,899 tons; in September 18,052 tons were produced and in October, 1933, the output was 15,116 tons. During the ten months ending October 163,250 tons of commercial salt were produced in Canada as compared with 148,280 tons a year ago.

Exports of salt from Canada in October rose to 1,471 tons from the September total of 821 tons.

Canadian imports of salt advanced to 22,155 tons worth \$94,802 from the preceding month's total of 11,653 tons at \$58,512. The October importations were obtained from the following countries: the United States, 37.3 per cent; Great Britain, 26.9 per cent; Poland and Danzig, 14.4 per cent; French Africa, 10.6 per cent; Italy, 7.5 per cent; British West Indies, 2.4 per cent, and Germany and Newfoundland, the remainder. These imports consisted of 1,671 tons of table salt, 8,919 tons of salt for fisheries, 3,637 tons of salt in bulk and 7,928 tons of other salt.
