FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1934.

FELDSPAR - Feldspar shipments by Canadian producers in November amounted to 1,691 tons; in the preceding month 1,910 tons were shipped and in November, 1933, the total was 1,304 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. A 53 per cent advance was recorded in the tonnage shipped during the first eleven months of 1934 as compared with the corresponding period of 1933; the totals were 14,424 tons and 9.430 tons, respectively.

Imports of ground feldspar in November amounted to 72 tons; during October 4 tons were imported. Receipts of ground feldspar during the eleven months ending November totalled 867 tons appraised at \$13,231 as against 436 tons at \$6,552 in the corresponding months of 1933.

SAIT - Canada produced 20,279 tons of commercial salt in November as compared with 21,899 tons in October and 18,477 tons in November, 1933. The eleven months production totalled 183,529 tons or lo.1 per cent above the tonnage produced during the period January to November, 1933.

Salt exports declined to 1,011 tons in November from the October total of 1,471 tons.

Imports of salt into Canada in November amounted to 16,960 tons worth \$75,584; in October 22,155 tons at \$94,802 were imported. Great Britain supplied 33.1 per cent of the November importations; the United States, 19.0 per cent; Italy, 18.2 per cent; Spain, 17.1 per cent; British West Indies, 9.2 per cent; Germany, 3.3 per cent, and Newfoundland, the remainder. These imports included 32 tons of table salt, 6,921 tons of salt for fisheries, 3,036 tons of salt in bulk and 6,971 tons of other salt.
