FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA, JUNE, 1934.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar during June were recorded at 936 tons as compared with 506 tons in the preceding month and 864 tons in June, 1933, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the six months ending June, 5,992 tons of feldspar were shipped; in the corresponding months of 1933 shipments totalled 2,522 tons.

Crude feldspar imports amounted to 27 tons valued at \$344; in May, 33 tons worth \$301 were imported. Imports of ground feldspar rose to 100 tons appraised at \$1,143 as against 34 tons at \$434.

SALT - Canadian producers reported an output of 15,688 tons of commercial salt during June as compared with 20,082 tons in May and 18,605 tons in June, 1933. The total Canadian production during the six months ending June was recorded at 90,193 tons or an advance of 10 per cent over the output in the corresponding months of 1933.

Exports of salt from Canada in June declined to 525 tons from the preceding month's total of 603 tons.

Salt imports amounted to 14,930 tons valued at \$56,121 as against 21,578 tons worth \$75,269 imported in May. The following countries were the sources of Canada's importations of salt in June: Spain, 31.1 per cent: Great Britain, 24.2 per cent; Germany, 17.5 per cent; the United States, 16.8 per cent, and the British West Indies, 10.4 per cent.
