FELDSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JANUARY, 1935.

FELDSPAR - Shipments of feldspar by Canadian producers in January declined to 730 tons from the preceding month's total of 1,436 tons, and the January, 1934, total of 1,344 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Imports of ground feldspar into Canada in January amounted to 84 tons with a valuation of \$1,278; in December, 50 tons at \$1,024 were imported while in January, 1934, only 2 tons worth \$38 were imported.

SalT - The Canadian production of commercial salt in January amounted to 11,136 tons as compared with 11,531 tons in December and 10,503 tons in January, 1934.

Customs' records show that 745 tons of salt were exported from Canada in January; during the preceding month 731 tons were exported.

Imports of salt into Canada during January totalled 6,168 tons worth \$18,351 as against 7,642 tons at \$35,350 in December and 3,686 tons with a valuation of \$14,409 in January, 1934. The January, 1935, importations were drawn from the following countries: British West Indies, 56.6 per cent; the United States, 22.7 per cent; Spain, 18.2 per cent, and Great Britain and Germany, the remainder. These imports were made up of 3,638 tons for the use of the sea or gulf fisheries, 2,336 tons of salt in bulk, n.o.p., and 194 tons of other salt, in bags, barrels and other coverings.
