FEILSPAR AND SALT PRODUCTION IN CANADA - OCTOBER, 1935.

FELDSPAR - Canadian producers shipped 1,517 tons of feldspar during October as compared with 1,042 tons in September and 2,204 tons in October, 1934, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the ten months ending October shipments totalled 11,923 tons or 18.9 per cent below the tonnage shipped in the corresponding period of 1934.

Canada imported 48 tons of ground feldspar worth \$994 in October; during the preceding month 98 tons at \$1,849 were imported. Imports during the period January to October, 1935, amounted to 465 tons.



SALT - The October production of commercial salt in Canada totalled 20,303 tons; in September 18,139 tons were produced while in October, 1934, the production was 22,187 tons. During the first ten months of 1935 Canada produced 174,251 tons of commercial salt as compared with 165,394 tons a year ago.

Exports of salt from Canada in October were at approximately the same level as in September and amounted to 981 tons.

Customs' records show that Canada imported 14,028 tons of salt valued at \$64,926 in October; during the preceding month 9,921 tons worth \$43,633 were imported. The following countries were the sources of the October importations: the United States, 8,527 tons; Great Britain, 4,252 tons; Spain, 1,221 tons, and Germany, 28 tons. The month's importations were made up of 6,080 tons of salt for the use of sea or gulf fisheries, 3,940 tons of salt, in bulk, n.o.p., and 4,008 tons of other salt, in bags, barrels and other coverings.
